Raise Michigan is Hiring a Campaign Manager for Earned Paid Sick Time and One Fair Wage Campaign

Our History: Raise Michigan is the ballot campaign and coalition driving economic reform in Michigan to ensure that workers are treated with respect and earn enough to support their families. Forming in 2014, Raise Michigan is comprised of more than 35 coalition partners, including community and faith groups, labor organizations, and small businesses.

Our Current Campaign: Responsible for raising the minimum wage in 2014, including the first tipped wage increase in 20 years, Raise Michigan is now endeavoring to ensure all workers have access to earned paid sick time and to increase the minimum wage again, this time eliminating the tipped wage in favor of one fair wage for all. Earned Paid Sick Time is an essential policy for helping low-wage workers stay above water financially. Currently, 70% of low-wage workers do not have access to earned paid sick time to take care of themselves or their families when they are sick. This means that when they have to stay home they miss a day's pay and risk losing their job. It also means that many people go to work sick, which is not only a public health hazard, particularly in the case that they work with children, the elderly, or in the food industry, but also that they cannot recover as quickly and therefore are less productive at work. The One Fair Wage campaign calls to eliminate the subminimum wage for tipped workers, currently at just \$2.13/hr federally and not much higher at \$3.38/hr in Michigan. We believe tipped workers should not have a separate minimum wage from other workers. **We are operating a statewide ballot campaign to give voters the opportunity to weigh in on both of these issues and to make progress for Michigan workers. ARE YOU THE PERFECT CANDIDATE?

This Job: The statewide **Campaign Manager** will lead the efforts of EPST and OFW campaigns, by overseeing and directing this joint ballot campaign. Responsibilities range from fundraising, to staff management, to communication with the Raise Michigan Steering Committee and Coalition. The Campaign Manager reports to the Steering Committee, directly oversees the Field Director, and ensures all the various moving parts and goals of the campaign are met. The campaign manager will be the point person for stakeholders, funders and others to get most up-to-date information about the campaign. The campaign manager will manage all fundraising, field, and communication, and compliance activities of the campaign. This is a contractual, salaried position which requires long hours with night time and weekend hours often. We're looking for self-organized, self-initiating, pro-actively communicative people who work well and keep calm under deadlines and stress. A good campaign manager figures out solutions to problems and makes things work. This is a senior position and prior experience as a Campaign Manager is required. Other required qualifications include prior statewide organizing experience, coalition building experience, 3-5 years in issue advocacy or political organizing, experience with managing budgets, at least some fundraising experience, and experience managing staff. The ideal candidate is passionate about Michigan workers and closing the wage gap.
